# Technology

is only a tool,  
it will NEVER replace YOU.

We want all to understand  
Technology and how to use  
(PC, tablets, phones)  
in lesson presentations.

Please try and setup Tablets/PC,  
TV or monitor/sound  
before class to not interrupt the flow  
and take away the Spirit.

Tablets only work for small classes.

Larger classes connect tablets to TV or projectors and sound.

Most laptops already have  
large enough screens and speakers  
for most classrooms.

Larger classes, consider  
adding external speakers,  
connecting to a TV or  
display screen with speakers.

For larger groups  
or rooms (Gym or Chapel)  
use projector and screen for video  
and for audio, connect to the church  
audio system with the “CRAB BOX”.

HELP!!!

I don't have a laptop or tablet,  
or  
I only have a home computer.

So how do I do my lessons?

How do I show videos, pictures and audio clips with out a computer?

# Flash Drive

also called a thumb drive  
or USB drive to TV (newer) or Blue-Ray to TV.

Or burn a DVD and play it.

I have a laptop/tablet but  
I don't have a way to  
connect my device to a TV.

The Library about 15 different cables  
that can connect your device  
to a TV or projector.

Check with me after on  
what cable(s) you might need  
and to see if there is a way  
for your device to work.

## My Problem!!!

I use my PC or tablet and show directly  
off the Church website

but it does not always work, it can be sluggish  
and sometimes flat out stops, why?

# Why is Wi-Fi slow or stops?

Too many devices connecting to it and bandwidth limits. Most devices are AUTO connecting once you are in range. Pull out your phone and see, it is connected and taking a slot.

Now add two wards phone, tablets.

Auto connect off would help if .....

Slow or not function smoothly  
will ruin your lesson  
and take away the Spirit.  
To solve this we recommend.

**DOWNLOAD** all videos onto  
your device **BEFORE** your presentation.

We recommend to **NOT** use Wi-Fi at all  
during your lessons  
for best results.

For best results use:  
Laptops, DVD, tablets  
to TV's, Monitors, Projectors,  
Flash Drive to TV,  
Flash Drive to Blue-Ray.
